

## **How to register to vote**

Every British, Commonwealth and Republic of Ireland citizen living in Britain is eligible to vote in this country's elections. All other European Union citizens are eligible to vote in European Parliamentary elections and local elections held here. To view the eligible countries click link below.

### Countries eligible

You can only vote if your name is on the register of electors (also known as the Voter's list). Every autumn you must complete and return the form delivered to your household. We publish a new register on 1 December each year.

We can add, delete and amend names throughout the year and update the register each month between December and August.

If you move to a different address you need to complete a new registration form. Only one person can apply per form and you must sign your form, someone else cannot do it for you.

Being on the Council Tax list does not mean you are registered to vote.
