- Positioning of camera on Sabine Road
- Request for road humps on Sabine Road
- Free standing advertising display boards on Lavender Hill
- Facilities for young people in the Shaftesbury area
- Action against fly-tipping culprits
- Installation of lifts and disabled access at Clapham Junction
- Need to clean up railway bridges on Latchmere Road
- Measures to discourage traffic from Stormont Road
- Neighbourhood Watch scheme on Shaftesbury Estate
- Recycling of large cardboard pieces
- Encouraging residents to recycle
- Encouraging residents not to put waste out too early
- Request for increased dog patrols on Shaftesbury Estate and more dog bins.
- Problem of road rage incidents on Stormont Road
