

At the recent West Hill Report Back Meeting on 23rd May 2007 a range of issues were discussed, including:

- Construction traffic and the recouping of costs for any damage to pavements and road surfaces caused by construction vehicles
- The enforcement of hours restricting construction work
- Consultation on planning applications
- The provision of underground parking on new developments
- Availability of affordable housing
- Restrictions on parking HGVs on residential streets overnight
- Enforcement of double yellow lines on Beaumont Road
- Request for a CPZ in the Augustus Road area
- Pot holes
- The change in rules on green waste collection
- Hedges overhanging pavements
- Street sweeping
- Anti-social behaviour outside of and directed at a local newsagent
- Signs for the Ackroydon West estate to advise of the ban on dogs being exercised on the estate
- CCTV provision in the area
