- We will generally need all adults over the age of 18 who will be living at the new property to become joint applicants. This does not include children of the main person applying if they are under 30.
- All joint applicants must fill in a joint application form. If there is more than one joint applicant applying, you will need to take photocopies of the joint application form.
- The main person applying and all joint applicants must sign section 8 of this form.
