

At the recent Roehampton Report Back Meeting on 20th October 2008 a range of issues were discussed, including:

- The development of polyclinics and the retention of GP surgeries in the area
- The need for a pharmacy in the area
- Cleaning of Kimpton House
- Nuisance caused by students
- Drug users congregating in Kimpton House
- Cleaning of and repairs to Woodcote House
- Problems with vandalism to blocks in the area
- The charges made by the Council to leaseholders
- Cleaning of the streets in the area
- Problems with dogs and people urinating in lifts
- Problems with people spitting in lifts
- The high traffic volumes using Holybourne Avenue and need for a pedestrian crossing facility
- The Transport for London proposal to prevent right turns from Roehampton Lane into Medfield Street, Ponsonby Road and Rodway Road.
- The regeneration proposals for Roehampton
- A request for double glazing at Charcott House
- The removal of leaf fall from drains
- The need for additional rubbish and recycling facilities at Grayswood Point
- The levels of rubbish on Roehampton High Street and Blackford Steps
