

Review of polling districts and polling places

Wandsworth Borough Council has carried out a review of all of the polling districts and polling places in the Borough. This is required under Section 16 of the Electoral Administration Act 2006.

The initial proposals were submitted to the General Purposes Committee on 10th October 2007, and the report by the Chief Executive and Director of Administration and Returning Officer proposed the division of the SMD polling district in St. Mary's Park Ward in the Battersea constituency into two: an eastern SMD district and a new western SME district, to cater for new developments at Battersea Reach.

The final proposals were submitted to the General Purposes Committee on 28th November 2007, and were adopted by the Council at its meeting on 12th December 2007.

The new boundaries for the revised polling districts SMD and SME will be published on 31st December 2007.
