- Confirmation that there was no planned introduction of wheelie-bins
- Charging for removal of bulk waste e.g. washing machines etc.
- Litter on Undine Street
- Concerns regarding operation of 'scaffolding yard' in Dewey Street
- Concerns regarding development of 144 Longley Road
- Action being taken by the Council to combat crime in the area
- Planned new bus stops on Blackshaw Road
- Double parking and a lack of enforcement of parking controls outside St. Boniface School
- Control of the fox population
