

At the recent Wandsworth Common 'Listening to You' meeting on 12th September 2007 a range of issues were discussed, including:

- Replacement of street trees.
- Enforcement of segregated cycle path on Wandsworth Common.
- Provision of cycle path on Burntwood Lane between Sandgate Lane and Trinity Road.
- Street cleaning of Burntwood Grange Road.
- Litter problems on Tilehurst Road and Fieldview.
- Debris left on Jessica Road following works by utility company.
- Request for alternative traffic calming scheme in Magdalen Road.
- Enforcement of banned right turn for cars from Trinity Road into Bellvue Road.
- Request for a pedestrian crossing to be installed on Magdalen Road.
- Request for a longer timescale for residents to submit objections to planning applications for telephone masts.
- Enquiry as to whether development of property on Heathfield Road was in keeping with the planning permission granted.
- Future of Alvering Library building.
- What arrangements would be made to enable the young, elderly and disabled who use Alvering Library to continue accessing library services.
- Whether the Young's Brewery site would provide a more suitable location for the new Wandsworth Library.
- Request for railway authorities to paint Earlsfield Railway Bridge.
- Concerns regarding the installation of CCTV cameras on the "Toast Rack".
- Whether permission was required to convert a front garden into parking spaces.
- Designation of conservation areas.
- Emergency repair work carried out by Council on wall on Collamore Avenue.
- Request for an update on future of Bolingbroke Hospital.
