

Location

Wandsworth is well served by a network of road, rail, London Underground (metro), river and air services. The A3 and South Circular roads serve the borough. The M3, M4 and M25 motorways are easily accessible.

There are frequent bus services to central, south and west London. Mainline rail services to the south and south east and to London Waterloo and London Victoria stop in Wandsworth at Clapham Junction - the busiest railway station in the UK.

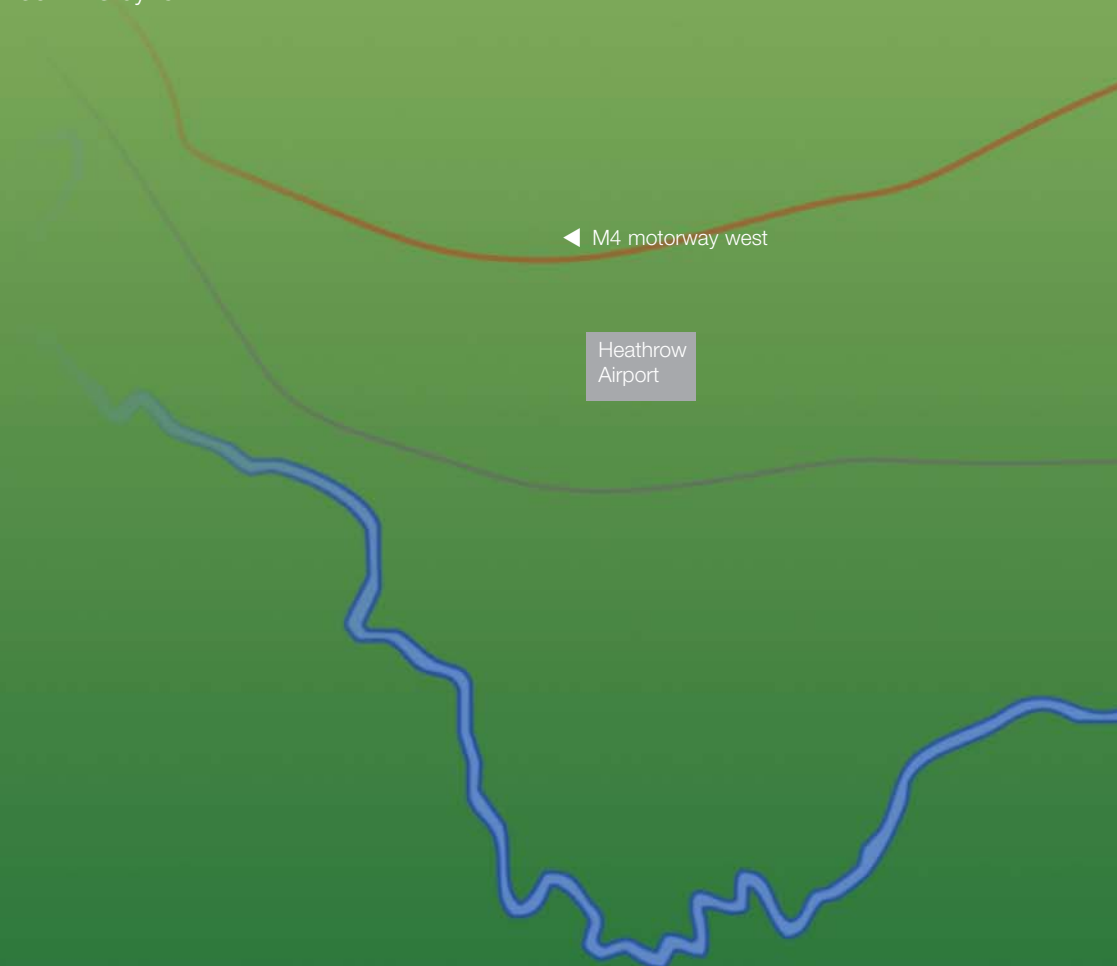

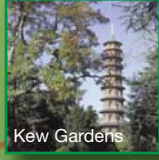

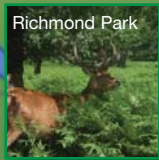
