D5 CPZ - One hour extension - Parking Review Consultation

At its meeting in June 2008, the Planning and Transportation Overview and Scrutiny Committee agreed to the introduction of parking controls in the remaining uncontrolled part of Magdalen Road and in Routh Road (between Trinity Road and Lyford Road). It was also agreed that, after a period of three months, a further review of the parking situation should be conducted. The aim of the review is to assess whether the current controls are still providing effective parking for residents and businesses within the controlled parking zone (CPZ), as well as providing parking for visitors outside the controlled hour.

The review is undertaken in a number of stages. We undertake a 'desktop' review of the comments and letters received from residents and businesses regarding the CPZ. We also look at parking ticket 'hotspots' that may suggest we need to clarify the restrictions on the street. We aim to complete the analysis by hearing your views.

You now have the opportunity to let us know what changes, if any, you think should be made to the parking controls in your streets.

When completing the questionnaire, it should be borne in mind that any extension of the one hour parking control would still allow non-residents to park (i.e. business permit holders and pay and display visitors). In addition, an extension to the hour of control would also reduce the ability of residents to park on yellow lines, as an extension in the operational hours of parking bays would also entail an extension in the operational hours of yellow lines, which are currently only in force from 10.00am to 11.00am, Monday to Friday in your area, unless signed to indicate longer hours.

Please also be aware that the cost of a resident permit within a one-hour zone is the same as that in an all-day zone.
