### Introduction of a Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ)

You may recall that we carried out a consultation on the possible introduction of parking controls in your area in March 2008. The proposals were for a Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) to be introduced on the highway roads for which the Council's Technical Services Department is responsible and for a Parking Regulation Scheme (PRS) to be introduced on the estate roads and areas adjacent to properties for which the Housing Department is responsible. The results are shown below.

The consultation results were presented to the Planning and Transportation Overview and Scrutiny Committee at their meeting on 2 July 2009. As they show that the majority of respondents are in favour of a combined CPZ and PRS scheme with the CPZ operating from 9.30am to 4.30pm, Monday to Friday, the committee supported and the Council's Executive subsequently approved the introduction of a combined CPZ and PRS in the area.

The PRS will operate from 7.00am to 7.00pm, Monday to Saturday as they do on estates throughout the borough where similar schemes operate. The new CPZ will be an extension to the existing Garratt Green CPZ, called G1, and together with the PRS **will come into operation on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2009**. The new controls will be introduced on an experimental basis in the first instance. There will then be a period of six months for objections to be lodged and, following this period, a review will be undertaken which will include a further consultation with residents and businesses to find out if they wish to retain, amend or remove the CPZ.

Parking bays in the CPZ will be available to holders of valid resident, visitor or business permits during the controlled hours. A price list is attached. Each resident who has a valid permit is also entitled to 10 free one-hour visitor permits a year, for use in other zones in the borough that operate for one hour each day and in which pay and display parking is not available during the controlled hour. These are available on request by telephoning the Parking Helpline on (020) 8871 8871 between 9.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday, or between 9.30am and 12.30pm on Saturday. Alternatively, you may contact the Parking Helpline free of charge on 0800 085 0866 between 5.00pm and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday. You may also request these free visitor permits by e-mailing [permitprocessing@wandsworth.gov.uk](mailto:permitprocessing@wandsworth.gov.uk). Please note that these free permits are not available through any of the parking shops and cannot be used in the G1 sub-zone.

Vehicles displaying a valid disabled person's blue badge may park without displaying a permit in any permit holder bay in the CPZ (providing it is not suspended) and the PRS bays. The regulations about parking on yellow lines will remain unchanged. Motorcycles are also able to park without displaying a permit in most permit bays, except those reserved for specific users such as disabled bays. Motorcycles should be parked with their back wheel at the kerbside. Tradesmen working at addresses within the sub-zone may purchase trades permits to allow them to park whilst work is carried out.

CPZ Permit application forms and guidance notes are enclosed. The Area Housing Manager will be writing separately to confirm the conditions of the PRS and to advise on the arrangements for the issue of permits for areas for which the Housing Department is responsible but you should be aware that a valid resident permit from the Technical Services Department will not entitle you to park in a PRS bay and vice versa.

All vehicles parked in your road during the hours of control should display a valid permit with effect from 19<sup>th</sup> October 2009, although warning notices will be issued instead of Penalty Charge Notices to any vehicles not displaying a permit during the first week of operation of the new controls. **Please complete the enclosed application forms as soon as possible to ensure that your permits are processed in time for the commencement of the new controls.** If you need further copies of the permit application forms or guidance notes or any help, please telephone the Parking Helpline on (020) 8871 8871.
