Dear Resident or Business occupier

Parking consultation results - Kambala Estate, and adjacent roads, SW11

You may recall that we carried out a consultation on the possible introduction of parking controls in your area in June 2009. The proposals were for a Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) to be introduced on the highway roads for which the Council's Technical Services Department is responsible. A Parking Regulation Scheme (PRS) has already been introduced on the estate roads and areas adjacent to properties for which the Housing Department is responsible. The results are shown below.

There was a satisfactory response rate to the consultation but only a narrow majority of respondents in favour of introducing a CPZ. However, when all traffic management considerations were taken into account, the additional pressure on the limited number of parking spaces following the introduction of a PRS, as well as expected future demand for parking spaces as the number of uncontrolled roads in the borough reduces, it was agreed to introduce a CPZ on the public highway in the Kambala Estate and adjoining roads, namely Mantua Street, Kambala Road, Heaver Road and Musjid Road.

The recommendations detailed in paper No. 09-919 were considered and supported by the Planning and Transportation Overview and Scrutiny Committee (4th November 2009) and subsequently approved by the Council's Executive (9th November 2009).

How the CPZ works

The CPZ will operate from 9.30am to 4.30pm, Monday to Friday (as the B6 sub-zone of the Battersea CPZ). The implementation date for the scheme is **22nd March 2010**. The new controls will be introduced on an experimental basis in the first instance. There will then be a period of six months for objections to be lodged and, following this period, a review will be undertaken which will include a further consultation with residents and businesses to find out if they wish to retain, amend or remove the CPZ. The impact on parking on those in adjoining roads will also be considered to see how they have been affected by the changes and to identify the course of action they wish to pursue. We will then take account of your views in deciding whether any changes are to be made.

Parking bays in the CPZ will be available to holders of valid resident, visitor or business permits, and those displaying a valid pay and display ticket, during the controlled hours. A list of permit charges is attached.

Vehicles displaying a valid disabled person's blue badge may park without displaying a valid permit or pay and display ticket in any permit holder bay in the CPZ (providing it is not suspended). The regulations about parking on yellow lines will remain unchanged. Motorcycles can also be parked without displaying a valid permit or pay and display ticket in most bays, except those reserved for specific users such as disabled bays. Motorcycles should be parked with their back wheel at the kerbside. Tradesmen working at addresses within the sub-zone may either pay and display or purchase trades permits to allow them to park whilst work is carried out. CPZ permit application forms and guidance notes are enclosed.

Each resident who has a valid permit is also entitled to 10 free one-hour visitor permits a year, for use in zones in the borough that operate for one hour each day and in which pay and display parking is not available during the controlled hour. This concession is provided for residents who occasionally travel outside their sub-zone, to another part of the Borough and need to park during the operation of a one-hour CPZ. These are available on request by telephoning the Parking Helpline on (020) 8871 8871 between 8.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday, or between 9.30am and 12.30pm on Saturday or by e-mailing permitprocessing@wandsworth.gov.uk. Please note that these free permits are not available through any of the libraries.

All vehicles parked on the highway during the hours of control should display a valid permit or pay and display ticket with effect from **22nd March 2010**, although warning notices will be issued instead of Penalty Charge Notices to any vehicles not displaying a valid permit or pay and display ticket during the first week of operation of the new controls. **Please complete and return the enclosed application forms. The permits will not be dispatched to you until early March (approximately 2 weeks prior to the commencement of the new controls).** If you need further copies of the permit application forms or guidance notes, please feel free to make photocopy of the form.
