Dear Resident/Business Occupier,

Introduction of a Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) on the Public Highway – Results of a consultation with residents of Ellerton Road and Broadgates Road, SW18

You may recall that I consulted you in December 2009 to ask your views on having parking controls introduced in your road in light of controls being introduced into the adjacent roads. The responses have now been analysed. I am writing to tell you the action we are going to take based on the results.

The results of a consultation with residents on the possibility of introducing parking controls into the roads between Trinity Road and Fieldview were presented to the Planning and Transportation Overview and Scrutiny Committee at their meeting on 10 September 2009 (Paper 09-763). The committee supported and the Council's Executive subsequently approved, the introduction of a CPZ in Heathfield Road, Lyford Road, Loxley Road, Multon Road, Titchwell Road, Herondale Avenue and Frewin Road.

Following the receipt of representations from several residents in Ellerton Road and Broadgates Road, who were concerned that they might suffer from overspill parking, approval was sought and obtained from the Council's Cabinet Member to carry out a further consultation with the residents of these two roads. The consultation was carried out in December 2009 and the results were as follows:

In view of the majority support for the proposals and the good response rate (62%) to this consultation, approval has been obtained to introduce a (CPZ) in Ellerton Road and Broadgates Road.

How the CPZ works

Ellerton Road and Broadgates Road will form an extension to the existing Wandsworth Common and Tooting Bec CPZ, D5 sub-zone operating from 10.00am to 11.00am, Monday to Friday, and will come into operation on 15th March 2010, provided the adverse weather conditions experienced earlier this year do not return. The new controls will be introduced at the same time as the adjacent roads detailed on the previous page and on an experimental basis in the first instance. There will then be a period of six months for objections to be lodged and, following this period, a review will be undertaken which will include a further consultation with residents and businesses to find out if they wish to retain, amend or remove the CPZ as well as a consultation with those in adjoining roads to see how they have been affected by the changes and to identify the course of action they wish to pursue. We will then take account of your views in deciding whether any changes are to be made.

Parking bays in the CPZ will be available to holders of valid resident, visitor or business permits during the controlled hour. A list of permit charges is attached.

Vehicles displaying a valid disabled person's blue badge may park without displaying a permit in any permit holder bay in the CPZ (providing it is not suspended). The regulations about parking on yellow lines will remain unchanged. Motorcycles can also be parked without displaying a permit in most bays, except those reserved for specific users such as disabled bays. Motorcycles should be parked with their back wheel at the kerbside. Tradesmen working at addresses within the sub-zone may purchase trades permits to allow them to park whilst work is carried out. CPZ Permit application forms and guidance notes are enclosed.

Each resident who has a valid permit is also entitled to 10 free one-hour visitor permits a year, for use in zones in the borough that operate for one hour each day and in which pay and display parking is not available during the controlled hour. This concession is provided for residents who occasionally travel outside their sub-zone, to another part of the Borough and need to park during the operation of a one-hour CPZ. These are available on request by telephoning the Parking Helpline on (020) 8871 8871 between 8.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday, or between 9.30am and 12.30pm on Saturday or by e-mailing permitprocessing@wandsworth.gov.uk. **Please note that these free permits are not available through any of the libraries.**

All vehicles parked in your road during the hour of control should display a valid permit with effect from 15th March 2010, although warning notices will be issued instead of

Penalty Charge Notices to any vehicles not displaying a permit during the first week of operation of the new controls.

Please complete and return the enclosed application forms. The permits will not be dispatched until nearer the implementation date (approximately 2 weeks prior to the commencement of the new controls).
