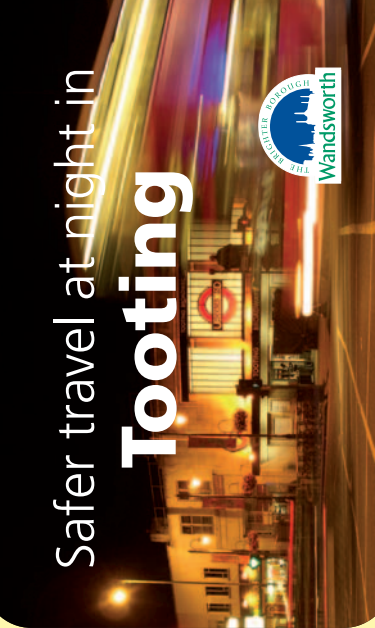

Staying Safe on Public Transport

- Buses:**
- Always walk to and from the bus stop using well-lit routes
 - Always wait at well-lit stops
 - Have your ticket or the correct change ready so you don't have to get your purse or wallet out
 - If you feel concerned about your safety, you should sit close to the driver
 - Ask for help if you need it and if threatened, make as much noise as possible
- Tubes and Trains:**
- When waiting for your train, stay in well lit areas, preferably near the ticket office or help point – help points have telephones that will connect you to the British Transport Police or station staff
 - Use the busier, middle carriages
 - It's better to miss a train and wait for the next one, rather than put yourself and others in danger
 - If you feel uneasy, change seats or carriages

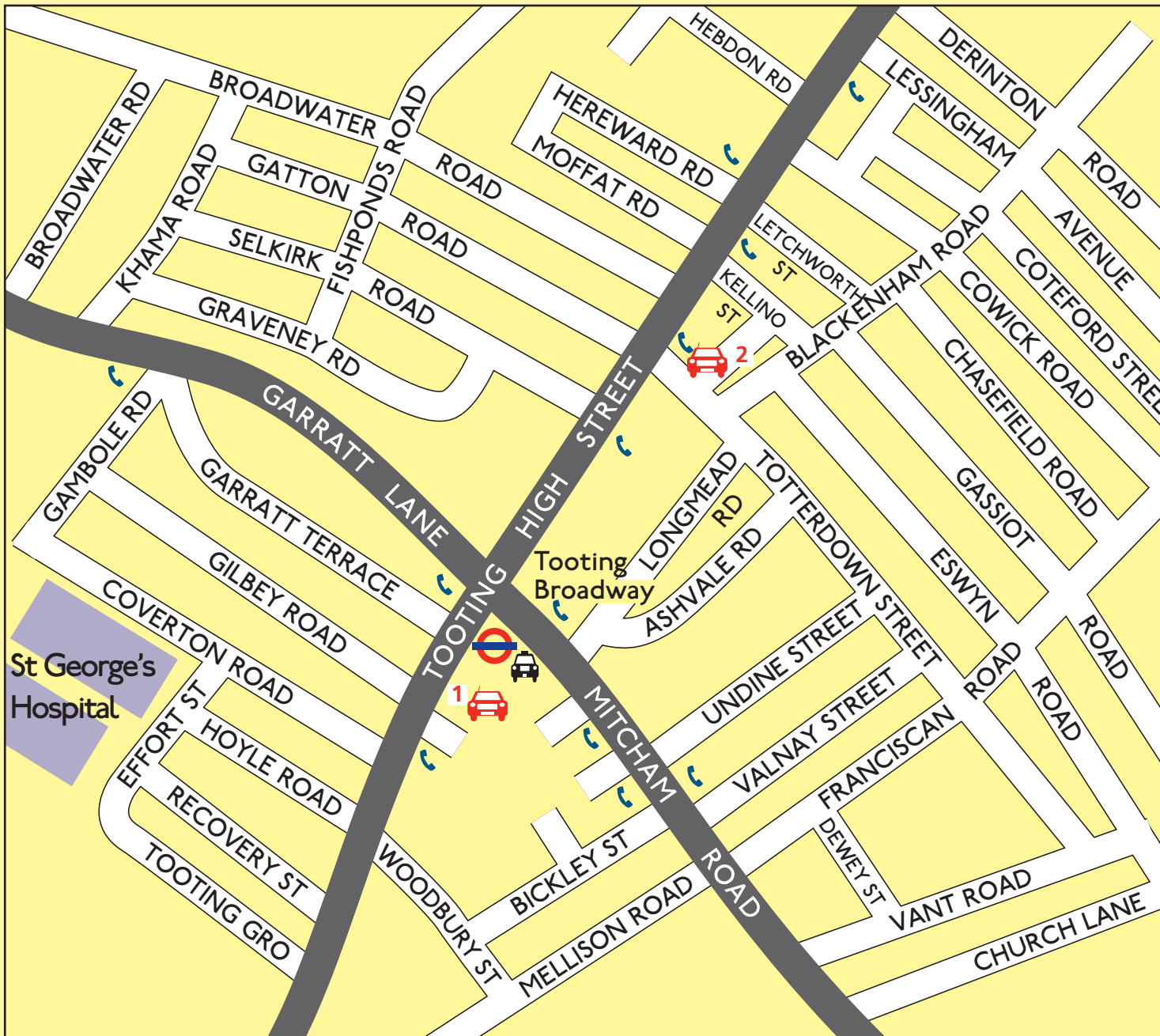

Safety Tips

- Before heading out for the night, always plan how you are going to get home
- Keep your wallet, purse, phone and other valuables out of sight
- Know that drugs and alcohol can affect your senses, making you vulnerable
- Beware of spiked drinks – watch your drink at all times
- Be careful when using ATMs
- Always tell a friend or family member where you are going and when you expect to be home
- Carry some extra money in case you get stranded and need to pay for another bus, train or cab
- Know where you are going and look confident by walking with your head up. Don't walk with your hands in your pockets
- Be aware of what is going on around you
- Carry a personal alarm
- Always use well-lit routes; don't take shortcuts through darkened areas
- Walk against the flow of traffic to avoid kerb crawlers

Cabs

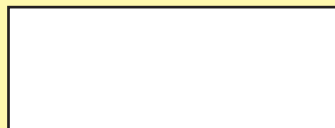
- Try to book a taxi or licensed minicab ahead of time
- Alternatively, ask your host or the venue's staff for the phone number of a licensed minicab company to book one. Ask for the driver's name and colour of the car that will be coming for you. When the minicab arrives, ask the driver to confirm your name and destination to make sure it is the minicab you ordered
- Do not hail a minicab. Only taxis (black cabs) can be hailed. Do not accept a lift from a minicab driver touting for trade. Unbooked minicabs are illegal and unsafe
- Sit in the back seat behind the driver and keep your phone switched on
- Try to share a taxi or minicab with a friend
- If you feel uneasy, ask to be let out in a busy, well-lit area. If the driver refuses to let you out, call the Police
- Text "HOME" to 60835 to get the phone numbers of 2 licensed minicab companies operating in the area you are texting from*
- Call 0871 871 8710 to book a taxi

1. TEXT: HOME to 60835 to get the numbers of one taxi and two local, licensed minicab companies*
2. PHONE: one of them
3. CAB: picks you up
4. HOME: safe and sound

* Text charged at 35p per enquiry plus standard text message rate. Roaming rates apply to overseas networks. Customers on Virgin, 3 and overseas networks need to enter different information. See tfl.gov.uk/cabwise for further details.
