ADOPTION STATEMENT

ROEHAMPTON SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT

In accordance with Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that on 14 October 2015 Wandsworth Council formally adopted its Roehampton SPD.

The Roehampton SPD adds further definition to the Council's adopted Local Plan (formerly Local Development Framework) Development Plan Documents – Core Strategy, Development Management Policies Document and Site Specific Allocations Document. Its primary purpose is to provide guidance to prospective developers, stakeholders and residents on the natures and form of development that the council is likely to deem acceptable in the SPD area.

The Roehampton SPD translates into planning policy the proposals outlined in the Alton Area Masterplan. The SPD does not contain new policies, but rather provides detailed supplementary guidance.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
