Request details: Redevelopment of Audiology House

As a local resident, I am concerned and object to the current proposed plans for the redevelopment of Audiology House, 45 Nightingale Lane, London SW12 8SP which I and many others believe not to have been thoroughly thought through. There could be a loss of an important public view and height/noise/light considerations are wanting.

As such my inquiry and FOI concerns the nature and extent of the pre-application discussions between the Developers of this site, Savills Planning, the owners, PC Werth Ltd, administered by its Trustees, of which Jeffrey Rubenstein, solicitor at Lawrence Stephens, being one of them, the consultancy firm, Snapdragon of SW9 6DE and Anderson, Wilde and Harris whom PC Werth Ltd have contracted, and Wandsworth Council.

Part of my inquiry but not limited to this are the questions below.

Has Pre-application advice been sought from Wandsworth Council by the parties cited above? And what level of advice/the fee structure of the Council determines certain levels for the cost of pre-application advice? If any redactions in the documents that you shall be sending me are necessary please could you provide clarification as to why they have been made? If any parts of the inquiry are deemed confidential, could an explanation as to why this is the case be given and if certain or all elements that are presently deemed confidential, will it/they at a later stage no longer be confidential, could a time-line for this/these elements be provided?

Could as much as possible, if not all of the Pre-Application Advice form(s) that was/were completed be disclosed, please.

Could you provide a list, notes, telephone conversations (if notes written up) and minutes of any discussions, meetings and correspondence that have occurred and is occurring relating to the proposed development of this site.

Has the Conservation Team had any discussions with Historic England/English Heritage as Audiology House whilst not a Listed Building, is of significant architectural and historic importance for the Borough?

More specifically, I would be interested in any correspondence between the Parties above and the Planning Officers - East Team, of the Planning and Development Division of the Council, Mr Tim Cronin, Head of Planning and Development, Mr Nick Calder, Head of Development Permissions, the Conservation Team, including but not limited to Mr Chris Grace and Mr David Clark.

Has the Council received any architectural drawings for the redevelopment of the site? Or any draft design and access (DAS) statement?

Finally, if the material above does not completely cover the Environmental Information Regulations for this site, SW12 8SP and the immediate vicinity, if the latter is linked /influenced by the former.

As this FOI is, regarding pre-application, could you also include material for December 2015 as you conduct your investigation and up to the day of remittance of the material if that is not too difficult or if there were a material change in the situation, for example a planning application submission.
