I believe approx 37 safeguarding alerts were raised at York Court - how many of those were substantiated?
How many of the 37 were related to institutional abuse?
What was the LAs outcome to their own serious service level investigation on York Court that started June 2014? But when did it end , and what was concluded?
There were many witnesses who alerted abuse and neglect at York Court hence the 56 complaints to the CQC alone - how many witnesses were included in that LA investigation that started in June 2014 and others?

The complaint tally of the number of health problem reports or health complaints, are to be the total number of every seperate individual health complaint, NOT the total number of complainants reporting on health issues, i.e. repeated and complaints by individual residents about one health problem or various health problems, are not to be counted as ONE complaint in the health complaint tally, but the total by that resident, and indeed all residents, to be included. If a resident has made a complaint about their health due to cold, and subsequently made a complaint about the effect on their health due to mould-growth, likewise this is not to be counted as ONE complaint but TWO complaints in the health complaint tally.
