## Clapham Junction Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ), C4 One-hour sub-zone – IMPLEMENTATION NOTICE

We wrote to you in July 2018 to notify you of the Council's decision to amend the CPZ operational times in the Clapham Junction Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ), C4 One-hour sub-zone to operate 'all-day' between **9.30am and 5.30pm, Monday to Friday**. The changes will apply to all parking bays and single yellow line waiting restrictions and will be effective from **Monday 11 February 2019**.

- Bays will be re-designated from one-hour 'permit holder only' to 'Shared Use'
  meaning that both permit holders and visitors using the pay & display/pay-bymobile facilities (4-hour maximum stay) will be entitled to park.
- Pay & Display machines will be installed during the first full week of February and the existing signs will be replaced from Friday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2019 to show the new times and type of control.
- If you already hold a C4 CPZ resident parking permit, there is no need to buy a new one. You should display your permit in the usual way.
- Visitors needing to park in the C4 sub-zone between 9.30am and 5.30pm, Monday
  to Friday will need to display a pay & display ticket/pay-by-phone or a valid all-day
  resident visitor permit (scratch-card), paperless visitor permit (PVP) or a trade
  permit.
- Disabled Blue badge holders will continue to be able to park provided they display a valid blue badge.
- From Monday 11 February 2019 until Friday 15 February 2019, vehicles without the appropriate permit, pay & display ticket (or paperless equivalent) displayed

during the extended operational hours will be issued with a Warning Notice, instead of a Penalty Charge Notice. This concession should assist in alerting drivers of the extended hours of control.

If you are a resident or have a visitor and haven't got a permit but need one to park during the controlled times/days, this is what you need to do:-

- If you do not already have an active online permit account or any pre-purchased paperless visitor permits you will have to set up a new online permit account. To apply for a permit or paperless visitor permits (PVPs) please visit the following website and register. https://wandsworth.tarantopermits.com/Account/Login
- You may also apply online at the Customer Service Centre in the Town Hall Extension, ground floor (9am – 5pm, Monday to Friday) where staff will be on hand to help you.
- If you already have an active online permit account, you will be able to purchase C4 all-day paperless visitor permits (PVPs) from **Saturday 9 February 2019.**

Although resident visitor permits (scratch-cards) are not normally exchangeable or refundable, we will exchange up to a maximum of 5 unused C4 One-hour resident visitor permits per household. Please return the unused resident visitor permits (scratch-cards) to the address below and ensure that you provide your name and full postal address.
