SPT 26	<p>Lower Richmond Road/Queens Ride Parking Restrictions</p> <p>(1) To make Traffic Management Orders under Sections 6 and 45 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to introduce 'At Any Time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) and limited stay free parking bays (operating Monday to Sunday 7am – 7pm, 3 hours max. stay, no return within 2 hours) fully on the footway outside Putney Lower Common Cemetery.</p> <p>(2) To extend existing single yellow line operational times on Lower Richmond Road and on Queens Ride from Monday to Friday 9.30am – 10.30am to Monday to Saturday 7am – 7pm from the borough boundary to the junction of Lower Richmond Road and Queens Ride.</p>	14.01.19
