### Wimbledon Stadium Parking Review - Results of Event Zone and CPZ Review

We carried out a consultation in March/April 2022 as part of the Experimental TMO review process to ask for your views on the Event Zone restrictions on match/event days and possible changes to the operational days and hours within your Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) when there are no matches or events taking place. This letter provides a summary of the results/decisions.

#### **RESULTS**

- Across all areas, a total of 5579 consultation documents were delivered. 736 surveys / questionnaires were completed, giving an overall response rate of 13%.

#### **Event Zone restrictions**

- A majority of respondents (73%) indicated that the Event Zone restrictions should be retained, with 48% indicating a preference for the Event Zone controls to be limited to event/match times, for example, starting one or two hours prior to the match kick-off or event start time and then ending one or two hours after the event has finished.

#### **Existing CPZ restrictions**

- In response to Question 7 (What days do you think the CPZ should operate?) in Earlsfield L2 (All-Day) (88%) and L2 1-Hour (83%) and in Garratt Green (G1) (84%) a majority of respondents supported retaining the existing Monday to Friday controls. In the part of the E1 sub-zone consulted, which currently operates Monday to Saturday, 50% of respondents support Monday to Friday.
- Question 8 (What hours do you think the CPZ should operate?) the most popular response was to retain the existing operational hours in all four areas.

## **DECISION**

Taking all relevant factors into consideration including the outcome of the consultation, the Transport Committee supported, and the Council's Executive approved the following:

1. The continued operation of the Event Zone restrictions from 9.30am to 9.30pm
2. The retention of the maximum permitted stay of 1 hour for those using the pay and display / pay by mobile phone facilities on match/event days
3. That no changes are made to the existing operational hours/days of the daytime Zones E1, G1 and L2; and
4. That officers should investigate options to reduce the Event Zone restrictions on match/event days in future

The Director of Environment and Community Services has been instructed to prepare a further paper for consideration in early 2023 by the Committee and the Executive detailing officer findings in respect of these further investigations.
