

Wandsworth Grant Fund – Eligibility Criteria Test

To understand if your organisation is eligible to apply to the Wandsworth Grant Fund, please complete the following short questionnaire.

For all organisations (but not registered sole trader arts professionals):

To be eligible to apply to the Wandsworth Grant Fund, you must be able to answer YES to all the following questions.	YES	NO
 Do you represent one of the following types or organisations? Registered charity Excepted/Exempted charity Community Interest Organisation (CIO) 		
 Private Company Limited by Guarantee (e.g., CIC or Social enterprise) State registered school Small (non-registered) voluntary/community group with a constitution and structure, including an Annual AGM e.g., residents' association 		
If your organisation is faith based, is the project you propose FULLY for the whole of the community, not just your members, and not of a religious nature in any way?		
Will all the Wandsworth Grant Fund funded activity take place in Wandsworth borough? (Exception: Residential experiences for young people outside the borough) * Does your organisation have 3 or more Trustees/Directors?		
Has the organisation been operational for more than 12 months and have an independently verified Annual statement of financial activities and/or bank statements?		
Does the organisation have an allied bank account with at least two unrelated signatories who live at different addresses? Does your organisation have Public Liability Insurance?		

* If the activity meets this exception, a 'No' answer is permitted.

For sole trader arts professionals only:
