WANDSWORTH COUNCIL THE WANDSWORTH AND LAMBETH (SPECIAL EVENT) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) (MOONWALK) ORDER 2023

The Councils of the London Boroughs of Wandsworth and Lambeth are satisfied that traffic in roads and lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order should be regulated for the purpose of facilitating the holding of the Moonwalk on Saturday 20th and Sunday 21st May 2023.

Therefore, the Councils of the London Boroughs of Wandsworth and Lambeth, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a) as inserted by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994(b) hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Wandsworth and Lambeth (Special Events) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2023.
- 2. No person shall cause any vehicle to contravene any restriction or prohibition described in the Schedule to this Order in the roads and lengths of roads and at such times as are specified in the Schedule.
- 3. The prohibitions and restrictions referred to in Article 2 above shall not apply -
 - (a) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency.
 - (b) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, a traffic warden or any authorised person engaged on the event.
- 4. This Order permits any authorised person engaged on this event to direct or regulate traffic to facilitate the safe progress of the event along the entirety of the route.
- 5. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the provisions of any other Order which conflict with the provisions of this Order are hereby suspended on 20th and 21st May 2023.

SCHEDULE

Restrictions and Prohibitions in the London Boroughs of Wandsworth and Lambeth

Road Closures

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to enter or proceed in the following roads and lengths of roads during the periods specified -

Rookery Road SW4 - from 19:30 to 10.00 (Between Rectory Grove and Clapham Common Southside)

Cedars Road, SW4 - from 21.00 to 01.30 (Northbound between Wandsworth Road and Clapham Common Northside)

Queenstown Road SW11 - from 21.00 to 01.30 (Northbound between Wandsworth Road and Battersea Park Road)

Clapham Common North Side SW4 - from 21.00 to 01.30 (at the junction with Cedars Road)

Lavender Hill SW11 - from 21.00 to 01.30 (at the junction with Queenstown Road)

Wandsworth Road SW11 - from 21.00 to 01.30 (at the junction with Queenstown Road)

Battersea Park Road SW11 - from 21.00 to 01.30 (at the junction with Queenstown Road)

Prince of Wales Drive SW11 - from 21.00 to 01.30 (at the junction with Queenstown Road)
