



Flytipping: **CRACKDOWN APPEAL**



A recent example of flytipping in Ibsley Gardens

Local people are being asked to be vigilant and help identify those who dump waste illegally on the estate.

Every minute spent clearing away flytipping means less time for standard cleaning duties.

The cleaners remove dumped waste to agreed collection points, which are easily accessible to bulk

lorries. Please do not add rubbish to piles for it to be collected: once the lorry has been filled to its legal maximum weight, it travels to the waste centre in Battersea to unload, along with several other councils' lorries.

Flytipping takes place for a number of reasons, such as when businesses seek to dispose of commercial waste without paying to do so, or when landlords refurbish their properties; and piles of illegally dumped waste encourage others to add theirs to it.

Where we have evidence, we will prosecute those who dump rubbish illegally. If you have any information, please contact your estate manager in confidence.
