

Appendix C: Additional Modifications to Wandsworth Local Plan Partial Review

The table below sets out Additional Modifications to the Wandsworth Local Plan Partial Review (WLPPR) to be made prior to adoption. Additional Modifications are minor changes to the content of the WLPPR that the Council has the ability to make but which have not been identified by the Inspector as necessary to ensure the soundness of the WLPPR. Changes that the Inspector does consider necessary are instead called “Main Modifications” and are set out separately.

The table below does not include very minor formatting, punctuation or textual changes that it may be necessary to make to ensure the published version of the WLPPR is as clear and usable as possible.

How to use this document

- The modifications below are set out in the order of the WLPPR, as identified under the heading ‘Location of Modification’.
- The Additional Modifications take the format that proposed additions to the text are recorded in highlighted and underlined text, and proposed deletions are recorded with a highlight and strikethrough. For example: ‘This text is to be retained and this text is to be added but ~~this text is to be deleted~~.’

Its policies directly supersede the six policies of the same name and number in the Wandsworth Local Plan (2023-2038) but should otherwise be read alongside the policies set out in those other development plan documents.</p> <p>Whilst legally the WLPPR is a development plan document in its own right, the Council plans to prepare a hybrid reference version of the Wandsworth Local Plan (2023-2038) with the policies of the WLPPR and minor updates shown.</p> <p>Further advice on the application of the policies within the WLPPR will be set out in planned Supplementary Planning Documents, and/or other forms of guidance that the Council may subsequently prepare. These changes have been made to improve consistency and compatibility between the WLPPR and the Local Plan but do not affect the integrity of either plan. include:</p>

- new or updated wording to introduce the Partial Review and wider context for the proposed updates to policies and supporting text;

- new or updated wording which is considered to add clarity or remove ambiguity over the interpretation of the Local Plan and the policies within it.
