ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)

TEMPORARY WAITING RESTRICTIONS

Battersea Park Road, Stapleford Close and Windlesham Grove

1. The Council of the London Borough of Wandsworth HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate lining works in various streets (“the works”) they intend to make an Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary road closure as set out in paragraph 2 below.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in the following lengths of road:-
 - Battersea Park Road (spur outside Nos.101 – 125),
 - Stapleford Close; and
 - Windlesham Grove between its junctions with Princes Way and Montfort Place
3. The Order shall come into effect on 1 June 2020, and the works are expected to be completed by 30 June 2020.
4. The Order will come into effect on 1 June 2020 and will remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months. The works are anticipated to be complete as indicated in paragraph 3. The temporary road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
5. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
