## Clapham South and Balham Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ), H2 One-hour sub-zone – Granard Road

We wrote you on 8 January 2021 to provide all households in Granard Road with a final opportunity to express their preference regarding the possibility of extending the operational hours of the H2 CPZ to 9.30am-5.30pm. This followed the decision by the Council's Executive to change the operational hours to 9.30am-5.30pm in Hendrick Avenue and Morella Road, but to retain the existing days, Monday to Friday.

Thank you to those who responded. We received 10 in favour of extending the hours to 9.30am to 5.30pm, and 11 against. The option to extend the hours does not represent the majority view of separate households to have responded to this final consultation. The present operational hour (10.30am – 11.30am) will remain unchanged in Granard Road.

You should be aware that:

- The operational hours are to be extended to 9.30am-5.30pm in Hendrick Avenue and Morella Road on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2021 under an Experimental Traffic Management Order (TMO). This will allow the Council to monitor the effectiveness of the all-day controls including any impact on parking conditions in Granard Road.
- There is a Statutory six-month period following implementation allowing comments or observations to be submitted which must be considered when determining whether any changes should be made to the scheme.
- As part of the monitoring process, the Council will undertake a further consultation after at least 6-months of operation with residents in the roads concerned and Granard Road residents will be invited to provide their views about any changes in their road at that time.
