ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS BEDFORD HILL, SW12

1. The Council of the London Borough of Wandsworth HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate highway works in various streets (“the works”) they intend to make an Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary suspension of a banned turn as set out in paragraph 2 below.
2. Whilst the works take place, the right turn ban from Fernlea Road into Bedford Hill shall be suspended.
3. The Order shall come into effect on 25 October 2021, and the works are expected to be completed by 31 March 2022.
4. The Order will come into effect on 25 October 2021 and will remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months. The works are anticipated to be complete as indicated in paragraph 3. The temporary suspension would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
5. A signed diversion for vehicles affected by the restrictions will be available via adjacent streets.
6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
