Introduction

We'd like to take this opportunity to introduce you to the team and provide you with some details surrounding the forthcoming development.

Site Development

This new development will consist of 8 homes to the South site and 4 homes to the North site, ranging from 1 bed to 3 bed properties including 2 wheelchair accessible units in the South site. Works are expected to take approximately 85 weeks to build.

Demolition Works

Helix is the appointed demolition contractor, proudly working in partnership with Wandsworth Borough Council. We will take site possession from the 19th February. The demolition to the disused garages at both South and North sites on the Platt Estate will then commence week beginning

26th February 2024 and will take approximately 4 weeks, to demolish.

Prior to this we would like to invite you to a 'meet the contractor event' on Monday 12th February 2024 (starting at 6pm and finishing at 8pm) at The Platt Christian Mission Centre, Felsham Road, London SW15 1DA. This will provide an opportunity to share more detailed information in respect of the construction programme, logistics, site management, resident liaison, health and safety matters and meet the team that will be onsite. It will also be an opportunity, for residents to ask questions and make any comments prior to main works commencing. We look forward to meeting you.
