## **Battersea Bridge safety improvements scheme: Final phases of work to start from 5 October**

As we near completion of the main civil engineering works for the Battersea Bridge safety improvements scheme we are preparing for the final phases of works to close out the project.

During these last phases of work we will resurface all of the roads that have been dug up and changed as part of the scheme. This includes Battersea Bridge Road in the London Borough of Wandsworth (LBW), Cheyne Walk and Chelsea Embankment in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (RBKC).

We will work at night to minimise the impact on traffic. As we are resurfacing the road we will have to close the bridge overnight and divert traffic while we work. We will reopen the bridge each morning after clearing the site to ensure the road network can function fully during the day.

Our working hours will be:

- Mondays to Thursdays, 21:00—05:00 (with the exception of Sunday 5 October when we will work from 20:00)
- We will not work on Friday or Saturday nights.

We plan to finish these resurfacing works in the early hours of Tuesday 21 October. However, in the event of unforeseen circumstances we may need to reschedule works at short notice.

### **How the works may affect you**

These works have been agreed with LBW and RBKC. We will do all we can to minimise any noise disturbance to our neighbours, including using acoustic barriers.

## Driving

Battersea Bridge will be closed in both directions each night on the 5, 6, 7, 8, 26 October and the 3 November. On Sunday 5 October the bridge will close at 20:00 to 05:00, all other times the bridge will close from 21:00 to 05:00. If you were planning to drive over the bridge during these times you will need to follow the signed diversion routes.

In addition there will be road and lane closures in place on all approaches to both junctions of the bridge. Traffic management cones, barriers and signage will be in place to safely manage traffic flows. If driving, please allow more time for your journey.

We will also need to suspend parking bays located on the roads listed on the closure schedule below at various times to support the works. Please check local signage in advance before parking in the area.

## Additional closures due to third-party works

We have agreed with LBW and RBKC to close Battersea Bridge for a further two nights to enable Marjen Ltd to install a crane outside the Glassmill (1 Battersea Bridge Road). It will be less disruptive overall to allow Marjen Ltd to do this after we have completed the resurfacing works, as this will require fewer closures than if they had to establish traffic management from scratch.

Therefore, in addition to the dates listed above, Battersea Bridge will be closed:

- From 20:00 on Sunday 26 October to 05:00 on Monday 27 October
- From 21:00 on Monday 3 November to 05:00 on Tuesday 4 November.

We are also working in collaboration with LBW and the Royal College of Arts to resurface Elcho St and Howie St while we resurface Battersea Bridge Road.

Signed diversion routes will be in place.

If weather or unforeseen circumstances force Marjen Ltd to reschedule at short notice you can expect to receive an update by post from them directly.

## Buses

Buses serving stops on either side of the bridge will be on diversion during our working hours. We will put up signage to direct customers to the nearest alternative stop.


