A greener borough

We have guaranteed your weekly bin collection and are investing in clean streets, great parks and clean air.

This year we're making big improvements to your waste and recycling collections through our Cleaner Borough plan:

- Borough-wide food waste collection is coming this year
- Greener trucks will run on recycled cooking oil, cutting carbon emissions by 90%
- In-cab technology will mean missed collections can be picked up quickly

We have reduced fly-tipping by 11% this year. Fly-tippers now face bigger fines, and residents can dispose of bulky rubbish at free monthly Mega Skip days in every neighbourhood.
