



ROADWORKS AND EVENTS BULLETIN

Week commencing 13th April 2026

Albert Bridge SW11 – The bridge has now reopened to pedestrians and cyclists following a temporary closure on Wednesday 9 April 2026, after sensors detected unexpected movement during high temperatures. Engineers have confirmed that there is no additional risk, however the bridge remains closed to motor traffic. A temporary support will be installed by 17 April 2026, while a permanent repair is planned.
