Dear Resident/Business Occupiers,

**Southfields Public Realm Improvements (SW19)**

You may recall the consultation on Public Realm Improvements in the Southfields station area in November 2015. The consultation received a majority support and has been approved for implementation by the Council's Executive.

The public realm scheme aims to create a village style town centre and includes high quality paving, additional street trees, entry treatments at the side road junctions, new cycle stands, upgraded lighting columns and recessed parking bays. The first phase of construction (details overleaf) will start during week commencing 28<sup>th</sup> October 2019 and is expected to be completed within 6 months, weather permitting. During the holiday period from 2<sup>nd</sup> December until 9<sup>th</sup> January 2020 work will cease.

Whilst we aim to keep disruption to a minimum, to provide a safe working area it will be necessary to close Clonmore Street and Elsenham Street respectively for 2 weeks whilst entry treatments are constructed, however access to properties will be maintained at all times. Replingham Road will also be closed at the junction with Heythorp Street to construct the raised junction table and the majority of the work will take place during the Easter break. A signed diversion route will be in place for the duration of the road closures.
