Progress to date

Excellent progression has been made in June & July along with many trades starting work on site. PHD Modular Access have brought their bespoke solution to scaffolding to Stag House and have nearly completed the entire scaffold erection. We have seen a dynamic approach to installing SFS (metal work) and windows by Stanmore. Plumbing and electrical works have commenced internally. Winchmore have begun installing external brick & blockwork. Internally, D M & C Ash have commenced the drylining works forming the walls of the new flats.

- Entire scaffold structure to be complete
- Brickwork façade and internal drylining continuing being installed
- Roofline to commence installation on roof
- Complete installation of windows
