Introduction

Welcome to the fourth edition of the 'Gideon Road Estate' Newsletter. Now that we have completed the enabling phase, we are looking forward to commencing the main works. Regular newsletters will be issued to keep all local residents informed on progress and site activities.

Progress

Since starting on site the following progress has been made:

- The new road construction and tarmac works were completed in December 2019 allowing unfettered access for the London Fire Brigade during the main works
- Following consultation with both residents and the emergency services, access and parking has been reserved for emergency vehicles - See photo below
- Site investigations for the future piling works has been completed
- Mains drainage and statutory services diversion works are complete

Main Works Update

Following conclusion of recent site investigations to establish the precise location of a concrete slab underneath the site, we have now concluded the foundation designs for the new buildings. We are currently anticipating commencing a main works contract with the Council in early April.

Forthcoming works

The anticipated activities in the near future are:

- Preparation for piling works as part of the main works
- Piling works and reducing levels
- Groundworks and concrete slabs
- Virgin Media diversion works are due to commence once a date has been confirmed. More details to follow.
